Recently staff of St Paul's completed 4 days of professional development in trauma-aware practices to **enhance students' wellbeing.** This was conducted over several months through the Berry Street Education Model. As a staff we recently agreed to embed key strategies from this training into our

daily routines to build on St Paul's culture of positive wellbeing for all. These are:

- Morning Welcome routine.
- Brain breaks at least once a session.
- Mindfulness/meditation activities at the start of each session.
- What Went Well Today (WWWT) at the conclusion of each day.

While there is no single recipe for classroom success, we are striving to be consistent with our routine/ language and modelling positive relationships to help meet the diverse needs of all our students. You can help by asking your child/ren at the end of each school day 'What went well' to keep those positive vibes bubbling in their young developing minds.

Viviane has accepted a position at the school her children attend, and Sophia has decided to move onto a less physical role due to ongoing health issues. Giving can take many forms so we are inviting families to consider purchasing pre-made pancakes to donate, to be given out for a Gold Coin donation to kickstart our Lenten campaign of supporting CARITAS and Project

**Compassion**. All pancakes need to be purchased to meet Hygiene and Safety guidelines. Ingredients need to be visible on the packaging. Please see full details on the poster. Year 6 leaders will help to distribute them on Shrove Tuesday at 8.15am before school. It should be a wonderful, community building activity.

There is an Ash Wednesday Prayer Liturgy at St Paul's at 8.35am next Wednesday in the Big Shed. All in our St Paul's school community are invited to attend. If you would like to receive ashes with the students and staff, you are most welcome.

This week's Virtue is Respect: To respect everyone, Christians are called to be conscious that God has created all people in His image, regardless of whether they believe in Christ. We should show everyone proper respect and honour because an individual person is of more value than all the wealth in the world. This idea is captured in the New Testament by Jesus in what we call, 'The Golden Rule,' "So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets. Matthew 7:12.
